WHAT YOU NEED TO TAKE WITH YOU TO LOS TOROS

(Note: also see web page "Travel" section.)

1. Passport and keep a copy of it in your carry-on bag.
2. Back-up Photo ID, like a Drivers License.
3. Meds - carry your personal meds with you in your briefcase.
4. Carry-On - Your personal clothes (see BELOW!!!!).
5. Notebook - Journal to write in.
6. Hat or cap, sun screen and sun glasses to protect you from the sun.
7. Water bottle or container for water.
8. Mosquito repellent with Deet or other strong repellent.
9. A small mirror if you have one.
10. T P or Kleenex for emergency use.
11. Towel, wash cloth, soap & shampoo.
12. A small flashlight for the evenings.
13. Good walking shoes.
14. Travel - Lunch for airplane or be prepared to pay mucho dinero in the airport!
15. Gift for your host family.

BAGGAGE AND CARRY ON INFORMATION!!!!!!THIS IS IMPORTANT!!!

Each participant is allowed to check one bag – this will be a bag of Mission Supplies to be used during our work in Los Toros. All of your personal items must go into your Carry On bag. We will allow space in one checked bag for personal things such as large bottles of shampoo, sun tan lotion, etc.

All participants will be asked to carry on either a briefcase or small backpack with a laptop or other mission supplies; you can put some personal items in these.

Please note – This is Very Important – your Carry On must meet the requirements listed below! If your Carry On does not meet these requirements you will have to pay \$30.00 to \$70.00 to check it. If your bag is Gate Checked you risk it being lost or delayed. If your bag is delayed you will not receive it until we return to Santo Domingo on May 29th!!!!!!

How Much Can I Carry On?



You can carry on **one bag** plus **one personal item** per passenger as long as the carry-on bag fits in the sizer and does not exceed overall dimensions of 45 inches (length + width + height). The maximum dimensions cannot exceed any of the following measurements: 22" long x 14" wide x 9" tall or 114cm (56 x 35 x 23 cm). All carry-on items should be stowed in an overhead bin.

Personal item - includes: purse, briefcase, laptop bag OR a similar item such as book bag or tote that does not exceed 36 inches (length+width+height) and must fit under the seat.

Additional items that will be allowed above and beyond the restrictions listed above include:

- Outerwear such as coats/wraps/hats
 - Book or newspaper
- Small bag of food to eat on the flight - see [guidelines for liquids](#)
- Approved safety seat for lap or ticketed child
 - Pillow or blanket
- Umbrella stroller for lap or ticketed child
 - Diaper bag for lap or ticketed child
- Assistive devices for passengers such as wheelchairs, walkers and CPAP machines
- Therapeutic oxygen provided by the airline

Check Bags – Important

You will be assigned one or two bags to check. Please record the number that is marked on the bag – it will be near the handle. Please keep your baggage claim tag – this is important – you need to show it when you pick up your bag at baggage claim – as you exit!

If you are asked what is in your bag – it contains Mission Supplies, medical supplies, health supplies, and sewing supplies, all to be used at the mission.
